01.
**Add your sites
to DubBot**

Register your sites in DubBot and monitor regularly. Aim for a minimum accessibility score of 90.

Audit your sites regularly with DubBot, WAVE, ANDI, or screen readers to identify and fix accessibility barriers.

**Make Documents
Accessible**

Ensure all documents (i.e., PDF, Word, PowerPoint) hosted on your sites are fully accessible before posting online.

Provide accurate captions, transcripts, audio descriptions, and keyboard-accessible controls for all audio and video.

05.
Use Best Practices

Use accessibility best practices: color contrast, semantic HTML, descriptive hyperlinks, labeled forms, alt text for images, etc..

Report template or system-wide accessibility issues to OUB and ITS Web Admin. This improves the accessibility of all George Mason sites.
